Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That These Hazards Were Observed: Room E--Sta (2), 591-1-1-.36(7)(b) Requires That an Emergency Medical Information Record Be Maintained in the Vehicle for Each Child Being Transported. The Emergency Medical Information Record for Each Child Shall Include a Listing of the Child's Full Name, Date of Birth, Allergies, Special Medical Needs and Conditions, Current Prescribed Medications That the Child Is Required to Take on a Daily Basis for a Chroni (1), and 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)4 Requires That a Light Cover Be Available for Each Child's Use on a Cot or Mat and Shall Be Marked for Individual Use or Laundered Daily. If Marked for Individual Use, They Must Be Laundered Weekly or More Frequently if Needed. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Blankets Were Stored Together in Room F and Staff Stated Blankets Used for Nap Were Laundered Once per Week. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
