Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Staff Statements That a Staff Membe (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined Based on Staff Statements, That a 1-year-old Was Observed to Wear a Heavily Soiled Diaper and Pants on December 10, 2025. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
