Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(15) Requires the Home to Ensure That the Total Number of Children Not Related to the Provider in the Family Child Care Learning Home, for Pay or Not for Pay, Cannot Exceed Six Children, Except That a Provider May Care for Two Additional Children Who Are Three Years of Age or Older for Two Designated One Hour Periods Daily Upon Approval Approved by the Department. It Was Determined Base (2), 290-2-3-.11(2)(f) Requires That Poisons, Medicines, Cleaning Agents and Other Hazardous Materials Be in Locked Areas or Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Clorox Wipes and Medication Was Stored Accessible to Children in Care. .
