Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Consultant Requested to View All Criminal Record Checks for Employees Hired After Last Visit. Director Stated That There Have Been No New Hires Since Last Visit Finding 591-1-1-.09(1)(j) Requires That for Portability for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, Excluding Students-in-Training, Only the Most Recently Issued Determination Letter Is Eligible for Portability and Must Be Ported E (1), 591-1-1-.25(4) Requires the Center to Maintain the Temperature in the Range of 65 to 85 Degrees Fahrenheit and to Ventilate the Center Be Ventilated Either by Mechanical or Natural Means for the Purpose of Providing Fresh Air and Controlling Unpleasant Odors. Facilities Which Do Not Have a Functioning Central Heating and Air-conditioning System Shall Make Fifty Percent (50%) of All Required Window (1), and 591-1-1-.36 - The Vehicle Had an Approved Fire Extinguisher and First Aid Kit on This Date. Consultant Discussed with Director and Driver to Ensure the First Aid Kit Is Complete. Finding 591-1-1-.36(7)(d)2.
