Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined the Light Switch Cover Was Missing at the Bottom of the Stairway I (1), 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children.
