Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(1)(e) Requires the Home and Any Vehicle Used for Transportation Children to Have a First Aid Kit Which at Least Contains: Scissors, Tweezers, Gauze Pads, Thermometer, Adhesive Tape, Band-aids, Insect - Sting Preparation, Antiseptic Cleaning Solution, Antibacterial Ointment, Bandages, Disposable Rubber Gloves, Protective Eyewear, Facemask, and Cold Pack. The First Aid Kit, Together With (2), 290-2-3-.12(5) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint and Kept Clean. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Brown Playhouse on the Outdoor Play Area Had Four Nail Points That Were Protruding to the Outside.
