Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Always Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staf (2), The Center Appeared Clean and Well Maintained on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom H 2L/Left Side Had a Green Bucket in the Bathroom That Contained Loose Plastic Bags, Bug Repellent, Sun Screen Lotion and Baby Wipes, Label (1), and Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (1).
