In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) - The Center Director Will Ensure That All Bolts Facing Inward on All Playgrounds Are Cut to No Longer Than 2 Threads in Length or Recapped. (1), and 591-1-1-.15(2)(f) Requires That Food for Infants or Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Be Cut Into Pieces One- Quarter Inch or Smaller and Food for Toddlers Shall Be Cut Into Pieces One-half Inch or Smaller to Prevent Choking.
