Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(7)(d)1. Requires That the First Check Be Conducted Immediately Upon Unloading the Last Child at Any Location Including, but Not Limited To, a Field Trip Destination, Arrival at the Center, and the Last Stop During Transportation to Home or School. The Responsible Person on the Vehicle Shall Physically Walk Through the Entire Vehicle (2), The Consultant Discussed with the Director to Ensure Any Child Sized Furniture with Green Cushions Was Checked Before Children Sat in or on the Furniture. (1), and 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site.
