Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(d) Requires That Outside Play Areas Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by Fencing or Other Barriers at Least Four Feet in Height and Approved by the Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children. A Fence Shall Be Provided Around Swimming Pools to Make Them Inaccessible When Not in Use. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Fencing Ha (3) and 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months.
