Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1), 591-1-1-.25(15) Requires That Any Outside Storage or Equipment Area Be Locked, Separated From the Children by a Barrier or Enclosure, and Shall Not Be Accessible to the Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation the Lower Left Playground Had a Storage Shed on the Building Wall That Was Unlocked with Three Mops Accessible to Children. (1), and Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Finding 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other (1).
