Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Please Secure Cleaning Tools (I.e., Broom, Plunger) Out of Reach of Children. (2), Complete First Aid Kits Observed in Center and on Vehicles on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.14(2)(b) Requires That There Must Always Be One Staff Person Present in Each Classroom Where Children Are Present That Has Current and Valid Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Training. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That Staff #4, Date of Hire September 12, (1), and Staff Stated Proper Knowledge of Diapering Procedures. Finding 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined Based (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
