Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Finding 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observations That Playground C Had Sticks and Branches Along the Walkway, 2 1/2 Inches of Stagnant Water (1), 591-1-1-.15(2)(f) Requires That Food for Infants or Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Be Cut Into Pieces One- Quarter Inch or Smaller and Food for Toddlers Shall Be Cut Into Pieces One-half Inch or Smaller to Prevent Choking. It Was Determined Based on Observations That Dinosaur Shaped Chicken Nuggets That Measured 3 Inches Were Served to Toddlers Without Being Cut Into Pieces 1/4 Inch as Req (1), and Discussed Staff Training. Please Obtain Required Documentation. Finding 591-1-1-.33(5)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program (1).
