Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Wipes Were Accessible to Children in the Follow Rooms: B-2nd Left Eagle on a Low Shelf, C-Left Far Back Penguin in a Hanger on the Bathroom Door, F-Middle Far Back Side Owl on the Bathroom Floor, H-5th Right Side Falc (1), 591-1-1-.13(6) Requires Center Staff to Have Emergency Medical Information on Each Child Who Goes on a Field Trip That Includes Allergies, Special Medical Needs and Conditions, Current Prescribed Medications Required to Be Taken on a Daily Basis for a Chronic Condition, the Name and Phone Number of the Child's Doctor, the Local Medical Facility the Center Uses in the Area Where the Center Is Locat (1), and 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination Must Have a Records Check Clearance Date That Is No Older Than (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
