Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.33(5)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department-approved Source. It Was Determined Based on a Review (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom 3 Had a Staff Member's Brown Hand Bag Sitting on the Desk and It Was Accessible to the Children.
