Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Consultant's Observation That There Was Not Adequate Resilient Material Beneath and in the Fall Zone of the Climbing and Sliding Structure in the Middle (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on March 29, (1), and 591-1-1-.36(6) Requires Written Parental Authorization for Routine Transportation Provided by or on Behalf of the Center. Written Authorization Must Include the Routine Pick-up Location, Routine Pick-up Time, Routine Delivery Location, Routine Delivery Times and the Name of Any Person Authorized to Receive the Child.
