Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Director Provided One File for an Employee Hired Since the Last Visit. Finding 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Chec (2), 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Peeling Paint Was Observed in the Follow (1), and 591-1-1-.15(7) Requires That Food Be Served According to Manufacturer's Instructions and Recommendations. Foods That Are Associated with Young Children's Choking Incidents, Such As, but Not Limited To, Peanuts, Hot Dogs, Raw Carrots, Popcorn, Fish with Bones, Cheese Cubes, Grapes and Any Other Food That Is of Similar Shape and Size of the Trachea/windpipe Shall Not Be Served to the Children Less T (1).
