Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.32(4)(b) Allows Children Who Turn Three Years Old During the Regular School Year to Remain with Two Year Olds for the Remainder of the School Year but Requires Agreement From the Older Child's Parent(s) for the Continued Placement. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Upon Arrival the Front Left Office Had a Staff Child Ratio 1:23 Among 9 Two-year-olds and 14 Three-year-olds. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Air Conditioning Filtering System Attached to the Exterior of the Building Facing the Right Side Playground, Were Unattached From the Gutter A**
