Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Observed to Be Accessible to Children on This Date: -Main C - the Cabinet Beneath the Changing Table Was Unlocked and Contained: Bleach Cleanser, Baby Wipes, Two Tubes of Butt Paste, a Tube (1), 591-1-1-.15(3) Requires Baby Bottles and Formula to Be Labeled with the Individual Child's Name (1), and 591-1-1-.31(2)(c) Requires the Center to Maintain a Copy And/or Written Verification of the Credential or Degree Awarded to the Lead Teacher That Is Required by These Rules in the Lead Teacher's File, to Make the Document Available for Inspection and to Provide the Document to Department Staff Upon Request.
