Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) - Please Ensure Hazardous Items in Diaper Bags Are Stored Inaccessible to Children in Care. (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and 591-1-1-.15(3) Requires Baby Bottles and Formula to Be Labeled with the Individual Child's Name (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
