Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Spray Bottle of OFF Insect Spray and Banana Boat Sunscreen Were in a Child's Cubbie in Classroom 3L, In Pre-K B, a Teacher's Purse Was Observed on Top of the Cubbie, In Pre-K C a Bottle of Cer'ave Skin Lotion Was Obs (1), 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the School Age/preschool Playground Lacked the Required 6 Inches of Resilient Surface. Less Than One Inch of Resilient Surface Was Obs (1), and 591-1-1-.20(5) Requires That Medicines No Which Are No Longer to Be Dispensed Shall Be Returned to the Child's Parent(s) Immediately. It Was Determined Based on Observation That an Enrolled Child's Epi Pen Was Observed to Be Expired and a New Epi Pen Had Not Been Acquired. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
