Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Staff Stated Proper Knowledge of Diapering Procedures on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.10(9) Requires Center Staff to Not Use the Area Used for Diapering for Food Preparation and to Keep the Diapering Area Clear of Formulas, Food, Food Utensils and Food Preparation Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation and Staff Statement Children's Snacks Were in a Bowl, Sitting on the Diaper Changing Table (1), Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute Throughout Playground Areas Due to Rain. Finding 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment (1), and 591-1-1-.15(2) Requires That a Signed Written Feeding Plan for Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Shall Be Obtained From Parent(s) and That Instructions From the Parent(s) Shall Be Updated Regularly as New Foods Are Added or Other Dietary Changes Are Made. The Feeding Plan Shall Be Posted in the Child's Assigned Room and Must Include the Child's Feeding Schedule, the Amount of Formula or Breas (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
