Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (2), 591-1-1-.15(4) Requires That a Feeding Chair or Similar Equipment Designed for Feeding Children Shall Be Provided for the Use of Each Child Being Fed Who Is Capable of Sitting Up but Who Is Unable to Sit Unassisted at a Table and Must Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant After Each Use. Such Chair or Similar Equipment Shall Have a Broad Base to Prevent Tipping, a Surface That the Child Cannot Raise, a S (2), and 591-1-1-.10(2) Requires Centers First Licensed After March 1, 1991, and Centers That Renovate Existing Plumbing Facilities, to Have a Hand Washing Sink with Running Heated Water Located Adjacent to the Diapering Area. Flush Sinks Shall Not Be Used for Hand Washing. Cleansing Procedures in Other Facilities Shall Be Approved by the Department. It Was Determined Based on Observation, That in Room B-1 (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
