Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(8)(a) Requires the Home to Maintain for the Provider and Any Provisional Employee or Employee with Direct Care Responsibilities Current Evidence of Successful Completion of a Biennial Training Program in Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in Pediatric First Aid Which Have Been Offered by Certified or Licensed Health Care Professionals or Trai (2), 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (1), and 290-2-3-.13(1) Requires That the Home Be Clean and Free From Hazards.
