Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(10) Requires the Center to Be in Compliance with Applicable Laws and Regulations Issued by the State Fire Marshal, the Proper Local Fire Marshal or State Inspector, Including a Certificate of Occupancy if Required Prior to Receiving Any Children for Care. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Smoke Detectors Throughout the Center Are Not Operating. (2), Consultant Requested to View All Criminal Record Checks for Employees Hired After Last Visit. Director Stated That There Have Been No New Hires Since Last Visit. Finding 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care Or (1), and 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (1).
