Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were Tears in the Diapering Pad in R (2), 591-1-1-.32(1) Requires the Center to Maintain the Required Staff:child Ratios as Follows: Under 1 Year or Under 18 Months if Not Walking = 1:6 (1), and Playground Observed to Be Clean and in Good Repair.
