Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(9)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year, After the First Year of Employment the Provider, Provisional Employees or and Employees, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department-approved Source. It Was Determined Based on a Review or Records That the Provider Did Not Complete 10 Hours (3), 290-2-3-.08(2) Requires the Home to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations (1), and Home Observed Complete Emergency Drills Finding 290-2-3-.11(2)(h) Requires at Least One UL Approved Smoke Detector to Be on Each Floor of the Home and Such Detectors to Be Maintained in Working Order.
