Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.06(4) Requires a Center First Licensed After March 1, 1991, and Centers That Remodel or Add to Existing Plumbing Facilities, to Have the Bathroom Area Fully Enclosed and Ventilated to the Outside of the Building with Either an Open Screened Window or Functioning Exhaust Fan and Duct System and Requires Centers Without Fully Enclosed Bathrooms to Ensure There Is Adequate Ventilation to Con (1), 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)1 Requires That Cots and Mats Are of Sound Construction and of Sufficient Size to Accommodate Comfortably the Size and Weight of the Child (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.20(3) Requires the Center to Maintain a Record of Medication Dispensed That Includes the Date, Time and Amount of Medication, Any Noticeable Adverse Reaction, and the Signature or Initials of the Person Administering the Medication. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That From December 1, 2025 to December 5, 2025, Center Staff Failed to Document the Date (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
