Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on January 22 (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.21(1)(a-o) Requires the Center to Establish and Implement Written Policies and Procedures That Describe the Center's Operations as Follows: A) Services to Be Provided, Ages of Children Served, Days and Times of Operations and Days and Times Closed (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Additionally, 2 Brooms and 1 Dust Pan Was Stored Inside the Bathroom Between Classrooms D and E and Accessible to the Children.**
