Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Was an Open File Cabinet Drawer Near the Back Right Area of Main A Open with a Pair of Adult Scissors and a Stapler Accessible to Children Posing a Safety Hazard. Additionally, on the Back Counter Near the Sink (2), 591-1-1-.33(5)(b)1. Requires the Annual Ten (10) Clock Hours of Training Shall Include at Least Two (2) Hours in Evidence Based, Developmentally Appropriate Language and Literacy Practices. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Staff #4 and #5 Did Not Have Evidence of Literacy Training for the Year 2025 as Required. (1), and 591-1-1-.21(3) Requires That the Center Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Center Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills for Two Years. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Center Did Not Have Eviden (1).
