Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.08(2) Requires the Home to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations (2), 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (2), and 290-2-3-.10(4) Requires That All Baby Bottles Be Clearly Labeled with the Individual Child's Name. Formula or Breast Milk Shall Be Supplied by the Parent Daily in Bottles. Only the Current Day's Formula or Breast Milk Shall Be Served. Bottles Shall Be Refrigerated at a Temperature of Forty (40) Degrees Fahrenheit or Less. If Formula Must Be Provided by the Home, Only Commercially Prepared, Ready-t (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
