Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Items Were in Need of Repa (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department.
