Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.03(2) Requires the Center to Keep Current Lesson Plans on Site That Reflect Appropriate Instruction Practices and Activities to Support Children's Development The Center Shall Have Sufficient and Varied Play and Learning Equipment and Materials to Support the Above Program of Activities in All Developmental Areas. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Lesson Plans Were Not Current T (1), 591-1-1-.12(6) Requires That a Variety of Age-appropriate Toys and Play Materials Be Available, Stored on Low, Open Shelves Accessible to Children in Each Room or Assigned Area. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two Shelves Were Not Accessible to Children in That They Were Turned Around Facing Other Shelves. (1), and 591-1-1-.15(4) Requires That a Feeding Chair or Similar Equipment Designed for Feeding Children Shall Be Provided for the Use of Each Child Being Fed Who Is Capable of Sitting Up but Who Is Unable to Sit Unassisted at a Table and Must Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant After Each Use. Such Chair or Similar Equipment Shall Have a Broad Base to Prevent Tipping, a Surface That the Child Cannot Raise, a S (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
