Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.36(10) Requires That a Child Never Be Left Unattended in a Vehicle. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on July 1, 2025, a 5-year-old Child Was Left Unattended on the Center's Vehicle for an Undetermined Amount of Time During a Field Trip. The Child Boarded the Center's Vehicle at 9:12 A.m. and Fell Asleep During Transit. The Staff Members and Childr (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities.
