Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Room M Had the Following Hazardous Item Inside the Classroom's Restroom and It Was Accessible to the Children: 1) A Red Swiffer Mop (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Statements, Interviews, and Video F (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtime, Nap Time, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities.
