Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.11(2) Requires That Personnel Not: Physically or Sexually Abuse a Child or Engage or Permit Others to Engage in Sexually Overt Conduct in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center (1), 591-1-1-.08(2) Requires Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations for Each Child Enrolled in the Center on a Form Approved by the Department, and to Allow No Child to Continue Enrollment in the Center for More Than Thirty (30) Days Without Such Evidence.
