Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.15(2)(f) Requires That Food for Infants or Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Be Cut Into Pieces One- Quarter Inch or Smaller and Food for Toddlers Shall Be Cut Into Pieces One-half Inch or Smaller to Prevent Choking. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Food for Children Less Than 2-year-old Was Not Cut Into 1/2 Pieces to Prevent Choking as Required. (1), Please Ensure Soiled Items Are Stored Inaccessible to Children. Finding 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.07(2) Requires That Parents Be Immediately Notified and Specific Instructions Obtained Until the Child Can Be Picked Up or Returned to the Group, Immediately When Professional Medical Attention Is Required, or When the Child Experiences Symptoms of Moderate Discomfort, or When the Child Is Involved in an Incident That Puts Their Health And/or Safety at Risk and T (1).
