Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), 591-1-1-.33(5)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department- Approved Source. It Was Determined Based on a Revie (1), and Proper Diapering Procedures Observed. Finding 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined Based on Observation T (1).
