Across 1 inspection since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Accessible to Children: Classroom A - A White Trash Bag Was Sitting Inside of a White Crib. Classroom B - Three Grocery Bags Inside the Cubbies. - One Box of Vinyl Gloves and One Box of Late (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department.
