(2), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That One Toilet Plunger and Three Toilet Brushes Were Stored in a Cabinet Located Under the Handwashing Sink in the Girls Bathroom in Classroom A and Accessible to the Three-year-old Children.
