Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), Staff Observed to Be Compliant with Applicable Laws and Regulations. Finding 591-1-1-.31(1)(b)2 Requires the Director to Possess at Least One of the Sets of Minimum Academic Requirements and Qualifying Child Care Experience Listed in Rule 591-1-1-.31(1)(b)2.(i-xiii). It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That the Acting Director Did Not Meet the Minimum Academic Requirements as Required. (1), and 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities.
