Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)2 Requires That a Crib Mattress Is Firm, Tight-fitting Without Gaps, at Least 2 Inches Thick and Covered with a Waterproof, Washable Material. Before a Change of Occupant, Each Mattress Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant. It Was Determined That Based on Observation That 10 Our of the 10 Crib Mattresses in the Infant Classroom Were Not Covered with a Waterproof Washable Material.
