Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.12(5) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint and Kept Clean. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the the Ladder on the Left Side of the Orange and Green Play Structure Was Broken with Rough Edges. (2), 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Playground Border Had Splintered Wood with an Exposed Nail. Further, There Was a Garden Hose on the Lawn Creating A (2), and 290-2-3-.11(1)(f) Requires Diapers to Be Changed in the Child's Own Crib or on a Nonporous Surface Which Is Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single Use Disposable Towel After Each Diaper Change.
