Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.10(3)(f) Requires That Food for Infants or Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Be Cut Into Pieces One- Quarter Inch or Smaller and Food for Toddlers Shall Be Cut Into Pieces One-half Inch or Smaller to Prevent Choking. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two Toddlers Were Served Sandwiches That Were Larger Than the Required 1/2 Inch or Smaller as Required by the Department. (1). The single finding was not critical.
