Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Items Needed to Be Repaired (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except When (1), and 591-1-1-.36(4)(b) Requires That the Interior of a Transportation Vehicle Be Clean, in Safe Repair and Free of Hazardous Items, Objects And/or Other Non-essential Items Which Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Three Vehicles Ending Tag Numbers 1097 and 8365 Had Trash, Paper, Food and Dirt Present on the Floor of Vehicle and Needed Cleaning. Further It Was Observed That (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
