Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.21(1)(r) Requires Center Policies and Procedures Include a Description of the Practices Followed by the Center to Prevent Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma in Children Up to Five Years of Age That Includes the Following Information: How to Recognize, Respond To, and Report the Signs and Symptoms of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma (1), 591-1-1-.36(3)(a-b) Requires Any Center That Provides Any Type of Transportation to Obtain Two (2) Hours of State-Approved or State-accepted Transportation Training, Biannually, for the Director and for Each Person Responsible for or Who Participates in the Transportation of Children. The Training Shall Include, but Is Not Limited To, a Review of the Transportation Rules, a Review of Approved Tra (1), and Evidence Observed of 50% of Center Staff Certified in First Aid and CPR. Finding 591-1-1-.14(2)(c) Requires That During Any Field Trip or Transportation of Children, There Must Always Be a Staff Member Present Who Has Current Evidence of the Successful Completion of Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Record That Staff # 5 D (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
