Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in the One Year Old Classroom a Container of Wipes, Gloves, and Empty Plastic Bags Were Accessible to Children on the Changing Table. In Addition, in the Three Year Old Classroom, Two Teachers' Cups and Three Air Fres (1), 591-1-1-.10(9) Requires Center Staff to Not Use the Area Used for Diapering for Food Preparation and to Keep the Diapering Area Clear of Formulas, Food, Food Utensils and Food Preparation Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Lunch Box Containing Food Was Observed on the Changing Table in the One Year Old Classroom and a Container of Formula Was Observed on the Changing Table in The (1), and 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant.
