Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (1), Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Membe (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Present: Chimps- There Were Adult Scissors and a Stapler on a Low Shelf. C-white Tigers- There Adult Scissors, Batteries, Tape Dispenser, Hand Sanitizer and a Stapler on a Blue Rolling Cart. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
