Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(9)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year, After the First Year of Employment the Provider, Provisional Employees or and Employees, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department-approved Source. It Was Determined Based on Observations That the Family Provider Only Completed Seven Clock (1), 290-2-3-.19(1)b)3 Requires That Sheets or Similar Coverings for Cots or Mats Shall Either Be Marked for Individual Use or Laundered Daily. If Individually Marked, They Must Be Laundered Weekly or More Frequently if Needed. It Was Determined by Observation Three Children Were Observed Sleeping on Cots Without Sheets. (1), and 290-2-3-.08(2) Requires the Home to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
