Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Potential Hazards Were Observed: -In Main Classroom C, a Broom, Dust Pan, and Grocery Bags Are in a Drawer Next to the Sink. -In Main Classroom E, Plastic Bags in an Unlocked Cabinet, Baby Wipes in the B (2), 591-1-1-.03(1) Requires the Center to Provide a Daily Planned Program of Varied and Developmentally Appropriate Activities to Promote Social, Emotional, Physical, Cognitive, Language and Literacy Growth. Center Staff Shall Use a Variety of Teaching Methods to Accommodate the Needs of the Children's Different Learning Styles. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classrooms One, Four, and Six (1), and 591-1-1-.12(5) Requires Center Staff to Provide Table Space for Each Child Who Is Able to Sit at a Table Unassisted and an Appropriately Sized Chair or Bench for Each Child Who Is Not an Infant and Who Is Able to Use a Chair or Bench. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Chairs in Classroom Two (The One Year Old Classroom) Had Been Removed and Placed in Storage Leaving No Appropriate Si (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
